## **ORIENTAL GIMLET**

Hadley's x Captain Bligh's Oriental Expression Gin, lime, mint

gimlets date back to the 19th century to prevent sailors from scurvy. Legend has it that while the crew consumed their lime juice with rum, the officers preferred gin, and the gimlet was born.

#### **FEIJOA FLING**

Hadley's x Knocklofty Feijoa gin, Knocklfoty Orange, Lime, passionfruit bitters.

A tropical, gin twist of a daquiri, a rum based cocktail that migrated from the Caribbean to the bars of New York at the turn of the 20th century (1898).

#### **CLOVER CLUB**

7K Raspberry Gin, sweet vermouth, raspberry, lemon, egg white

Sometimes described as the befitting drink of choice for a "Distinguished patron of the oak-paneled lounge", the Clover Club began its life in the Gentlemen's club by the same name in 19th century Philly.

### LAVENDER FIELDS

Adam's Blueberry and Lavender Gin, blueberries, lemon, sugar, mint

Twist on a Tom Collins. Beginning life in a coffee house in Victorian London, Tom Collins have been a drink of choice since the early 19th century.
